TWG18 offers a communicative, collegial and critical forum for the discussion of these and other related issues, which will allow diverse perspectives and theoretical approaches and will contribute to the development of our knowledge and understanding as researchers, educators and practitioners.

Call for papers and poster proposals

In TWG18, we welcome theoretical, methodological, empirical and developmental paper and poster proposals. Any paper or poster of relevance to the overall focus of the group will be considered.

We particularly welcome contributions presenting young researchers' approaches and studies.

Papers and poster proposals should use the CERME template, and conform to the guidelines at <u>www.cerme12.it</u> CERME 12 uses an electronic submission system <u>www.conftool.pro/cerme12</u> The authors submit the initial version of their paper on the website (uploading it both as a .doc and a .pdf file, and providing the required information, in particular the TWG number).

Reviews and decisions

Each paper will be peer-reviewed by two persons from among those who submit papers to this TWG. Please expect to be asked to review up to two papers. The group leaders will decide about the acceptance of posters.
