12th Congress of the European Society for Research in Mathematics Education
(CERME12): 2nd to 6th February, 2022

**** Submission and pre-registration now open ****

We are delighted to announce that submissions are now open for the Twelfth Congress of the European Society for Research in Mathematics Education. CERME12 will take place from the 2nd to 6th of February, 2022. The conference will be preceded by a YERME day for young researchers.

CERME12 will be hosted by the Free University of Bozen-Bolzano and will take place in Bozen-Bolzano (Italy). CERME is currently planned as a face-to-face event (under COVID-safe conditions). If this should turn out to be impossible, CERME12 will be held as a virtual conference on the same dates. In this unlikely case, the change will be announced in December 2021.

CERME is a distinctive conference designed to foster communication, cooperation and collaboration amongst researchers in mathematics education. Its main feature is that attendees participate in one of 27 Thematic Working Groups (TWGs). The TWGs cover a wide range of themes and provide an opportunity for researchers to work together. Plenary events will include lectures from Susanne Prediger (Germany) and Jeppe Skott (Sweden/Denmark).

Researchers in mathematics education are invited to submit a paper or poster to one of the TWGs.
