

## FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT YERME-Day 2022 (February 2022, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>) (https://www.cerme12.it/yerme-day/)

YERME and the Local Organisers are happy to invite PhD students, post-doctoral researchers, and master students in mathematics education and others entering mathematics education research to take part in the YERME-Day 2022.

The YERME-Day provides an opportunity for participants to meet scholars in European Mathematics Education from different academic traditions. In addition, it constitutes an important opportunity for meeting and networking with young researchers from other countries, pursuing similar and not so similar research issues.

The YERME-Day (for Young Researchers in ERME) begins one day before the CERME 12 congress, that means on Tuesday, February 1<sup>st</sup>, and ends on Wednesday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>. It will also take place at the Free University of Bolzano, Italy. [*Important note: Remember to book an extra hotel night (Feb. 1-Feb. 2) for YERME-Day.*]



## Program

The program foresees a "Gallery Walk", one plenary lecture and five working groups. Senior scholars in Mathematics Education will lead the five working groups (WGs). Each WG will have up to 25 participants, and participants attend two of these five working groups, one on each day. More details are available at the <u>conference website</u>.

## **Registration process**

The online registration will be available from November 15th, and ends November 22nd at 23:55 CET, via this <u>registration form</u>. Attendance at YERME-Day is free of charge, but to be accepted, applicants need to have pre-registered for CERME12. In case the registrations on YERME-Day exceed the capacities, a selection of participants for will be made, on the base of these two criteria: We will give priority to applicants, who (1) have never participated in a YERME-Day (pre-YERME event in 2021 is not applicable for this criteria), and (2) come from underrepresented countries of Europe.
